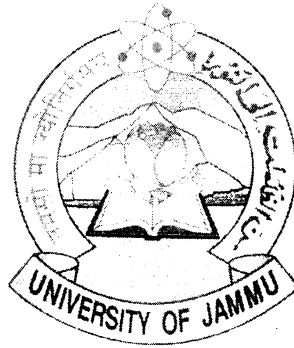

3.	<p>To confirm the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized the following :</p> <p>i) that the amendments in the Clause 48 - Absolute Grade System of the Statutes governing the Choice Based Credit System for the Master's Degree Programmes from the Academic Session 2017-18.</p> <p>ii) that the detailed gazette containing marks semester-wise, course-wise and grand total shall be prepared by all the Departments after uploading the data by the end of February, 2018 on the software to be made available by the Examination Wing, University of Jammu by the first week of February, 2018. The same shall be applicable to the students enrolled in the sessions 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17.</p> <p>iii) that for the students enrolled from the Academic Session 2017-18, the result notification shall contain both marks and the grades obtained by them.</p> <p>iv) that for the previous/backlog candidates who left the course and then sought admission (after gap) in any current session for any of the semesters, the Absolute Grading System in vogue at the time of their enrollment shall be applicable.</p> <p>iv) that if a student does not qualify a Course or Semester, his/her status, i.e., Fail/Reappear, should be mentioned in the grade sheet.</p>	24-28

In cases where the difference is equal in all the three evaluations, average of the three shall be awarded. b) The evaluation shall be made mandatory for atleast 300 copies in a academic year for all the faculty members. c) The limit of 300 copies shall also be mandatory for contractual faculty of the Colleges/University and in the absence of the same they shall not be eligible for appointment as contractual faculty in the following year. d) 3rd re-evaluation be not taken up for those candidates where status is unchanged from fail in re-evaluation. e) The 10% rider be qualified with the condition that minimum of 25 copies in the subject are there in 10% calculation. 	55-60

After the answer script/s is/are received by the candidate, he/she shall apply for re-evaluation within 10 days with normal fee and thereafter with late fee presently in vogue. <u>The candidate/s who will not take the photostat copy of the answer script shall not be eligible to apply for re-evaluation.</u></p>	The same is being placed before the next meeting of the University Syndicate.

6.	<p>Considered the confirmation of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the eligibility of having passed in 50% of the papers for admission in Semester-V of B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course shall exclude Environmental Science paper of Semester-III; 2. the eligibility for admission of students to Semester-III of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course under the Choice Based Credit System that stands fixed as having passed 50% of the credits, shall be rounded off to the nearest lower side where 50% of the credits come to be an odd number and where no permutation/combination of subjects/papers makes it to that odd number of credits. For example, where a course is of 22 credits and 50% of credits is in odd number (11 credits), the eligibility shall be rounded off to 10 credits; and 3. the eligibility condition of having passed in the internal assessment in atleast 75% of the subjects/papers of Semester-II/IV of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM.
