Consequent to the Meeting of the Appellate Committee held on **August 13, 2018**, the Counselling Schedule for admission for the left over seats for the various Academic Programmes of the University of Jammu i.e. the Main Campus/Offsite Campuses/Affiliated Colleges for the **Session 2018-19** is as under:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Canadian Test for B.P.Ed and M.P.Ed Candidates (in the Concerned Department) 	August 16, 2018 (Thursday) Reporting Time : 10:00 am
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Counselling for the Open/ General Category seats including the seats that fall vacant after conversion of the Reserved Category seats to Open/General Category Seats including transfer cases, if any and the filling up of the left over Self Finance Seats (in the Concerned Department/Nodal Department) 	August 17, 2018 (Friday) Reporting Time : Upto 12:00 Noon Counselling Time : 02:00 pm onwards

NOTE : The Admission Process for the Academic Session 2018-19 shall close on **AUGUST 17, 2018 (FRIDAY)** after the culmination of the Counselling Process. No admission shall be made thereafter.

The Broad Guidelines for the candidates are as under :

1. Any candidate who has not appeared in JUET-2018 is not eligible for Admission.
2. Any candidate who has not filled in the Online Application after the declaration of the result of JUET-2018 is not eligible for Admission.
3. Any candidate who has not applied for Self Finance Seat at the time of the filling up of the Online Application alongwith the requisite fee of Rs. 660/- is not eligible for admission under the Self Finance Seat.
4. Any candidate who has not submitted the requisite Reserved Category Certificate as required during the notified dates of Admission shall not be considered for admission under that category. As such, any candidate who has submitted an "Under Process Certificate" shall not to be considered for admission.
5. Any candidate who has not submitted his/her certificates for admission in any Achievement Category within the prescribed time is not eligible for admission in that Achievement Category.
6. Any candidate who is higher in merit than the ones who have been admitted and could not seek admission/ attend counselling for one or the other reason, he/she may approach the concerned Department for consideration for admission against the vacant seat/s, if any, such a candidate being otherwise eligible. The merit/inter-se-merit in such cases shall be adhered to and all the eligible candidates irrespective of filing an Appeal are hereby given an opportunity for admission strictly in order of merit.
7. The seats in the reserved categories, if still remain unfilled, even after exhausting the complete list in that particular category, the same shall be converted into the Open/General Category seats and shall be offered to the candidates in order of merit. (As per Statute 6 (B)- Explanation (iii)- Page 105-106 of Admission Brochure, JUET-2018).
8. The Supernumerary Seat/s cannot be converted into the Open/General Category seats even if they remain vacant.
9. In the event of no candidate being available in the 1st Preference and after the list of the candidates in the 1st Preference is completely exhausted in a particular programme/course, it is only then that the candidates who are seeking admission in the 2nd preference shall be considered strictly in order of merit and in the event of their being otherwise eligible.
10. The candidates who are admitted after the commencement of the Class work of the 1st Semester shall have to makeup for the lectures / practicals etc. on their own.
11. The Departments/Nodal Departments will do the Counselling and ensure that all Admission related matters of the Departments/Offsite Campuses/ Affiliated Colleges with respect to those students who have appeared in JUET-2018; have already filled in the Online Application Form; have already submitted all the Documents as required in time and who were because of one or the other reason not able to present themselves / seek admission on the date/s as prescribed/ notified by the University/ respective Departments and who were/are in merit and are otherwise eligible shall be within the ambit of consideration for admission subject to the availability of seat/s.
12. The Admission Process by all Departments/Nodal Departments for the **Academic Session 2018-19** shall be closed on **August 17, 2018 (Friday)** after implementing the various decisions taken in the meeting of the Appellate Committee and after the culmination of the Counselling Process on **August 17, 2018 (Friday)** as per the aforesaid Schedule. No admission shall be made thereafter.
