The amount of information that can be gleaned from datasets as well as the forms in which these results are displayed/expressed can make research infinitely richer. It is for this very reason that the participants will be trained in the use of SPSS and R.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

The proposed workshop been designed to achieve the following specific objectives:

- To enhance analytical skills of the young scholars who are engaged in doctoral work or involved in planning for their research work;
- To equip the participants in quantitative and qualitative research methods and strategies;
- To sharpen participants' competence in usage of SPSS and R;
- To impart practical experience with a variety of analytical tools to facilitate the analysis and enabling appropriate interpretation of given hypothesis.

DESIGN OF THE WORKSHOP

The content delivery will have mix of lectures, demonstrations, interactive sessions and hand on training on the SPSS and R for analysis of data. Desktop computer will be made available to each participant for practice and learning during the workshop.

Fees and Registration Procedure

There are limited 30 seats for this workshop and the selection will be made on first come first serve basis. The registration fee of the workshop is Rs. 1000/- for research scholars and Rs. 2000/- for faculty members. This fee covers the cost of Workshop-kit, Lunch and sessional teas.
